

# Magnus Hundt in context

In 1493, the “Compendium totius logicae” by the Leipzig magister Magnus Hundt was published. It not only received rapid circulation and frequent reception, but was also reprinted several times until 1517.

The remarkable impact and content of the treatise are good motivations to learn more about the context in which it was written. In doing so, we want to explore a wide range of philosophical, scientific, social, educational, theological

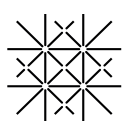
and cultural aspects. The aim is to understand as fully as possible the cultural-historical background of the philosopher and of his writings, which until now have been almost completely unknown.

The event is part of the SNSF research project “Magnus Hundt’s Theory of Logic” at the University of Basel.

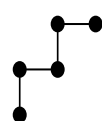
